



26 enquiries were received, four of which did not relate to Drayton activities. Of these 16 were considered complaints. These were discussed as required by members of the CCC.

Rainfall data for the year to date was compared to last year's rainfall pattern and historic averages. Above average rainfall fell in this quarter.

All blasts during the period were below statutory limits for both vibration and airblast.

Dust levels in the Antiene area were below EPA goals.

Background noise levels were within limits. The barn owl real time monitoring system indicated average noise levels were well below the Department of Planning requirements.

Water levels have remained relatively stable throughout the period. Included in this presentation is a summary of Drayton's water usage for the quarterly period. Drayton does not extract water from the Hunter River, nor do we discharge water offsite. Drayton is a nil discharge site.

Waste disposal data was also presented for end of quarterly period.

Offset work has begun with tree planting commencing in May. Final approvals of management plans have been received.
